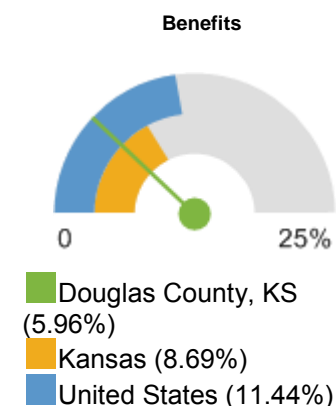
Economic and social insecurity often are associated with poor health. Poverty, unemployment, and lack of educational achievement affect access to care and a community's ability to engage in healthy behaviors. Without a network of support and a safe community, families cannot thrive. Ensuring access to social and economic resources provides a foundation for a healthy community.

Population Receiving SNAP Benefits (ACS)

This indicator reports the estimated percentage of households receiving the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) benefits. This indicator is relevant because it assesses vulnerable populations which are more likely to have multiple health access, health status, and social support needs; when combined with poverty data, providers can use this measure to identify gaps in eligibility and enrolment.

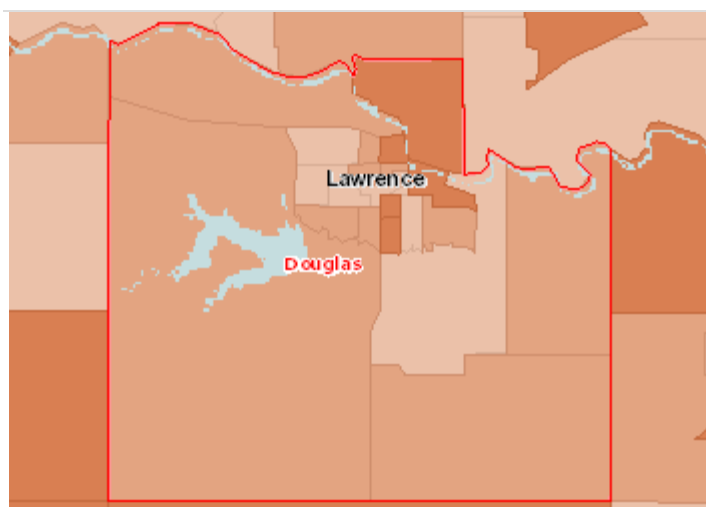

Percent Households Receiving SNAP

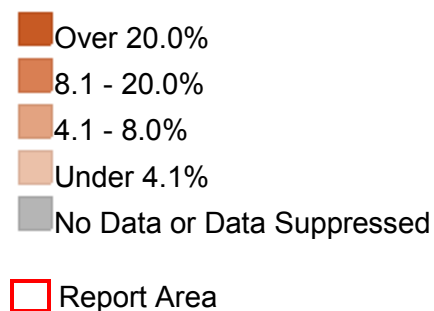

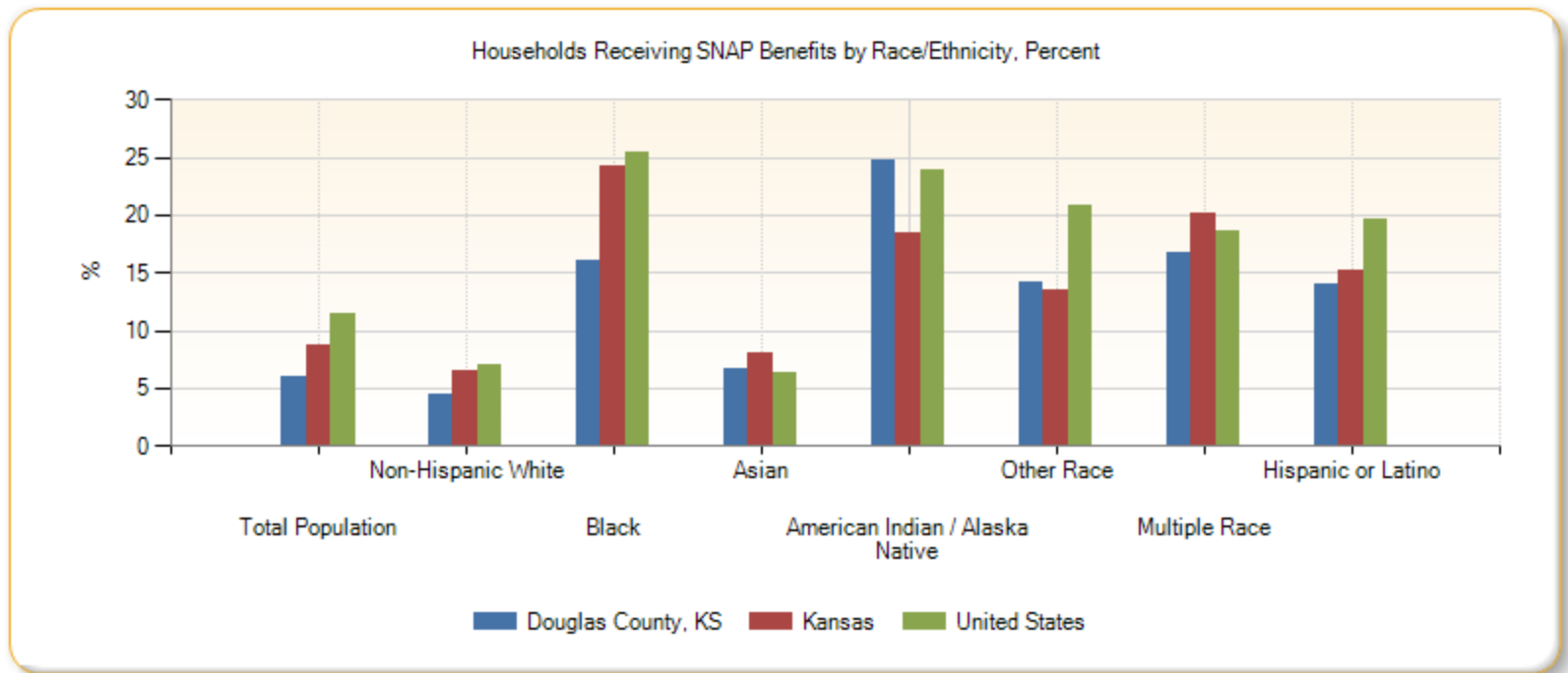


Households Receiving SNAP Benefits, Percent by Tract, ACS 2008-12



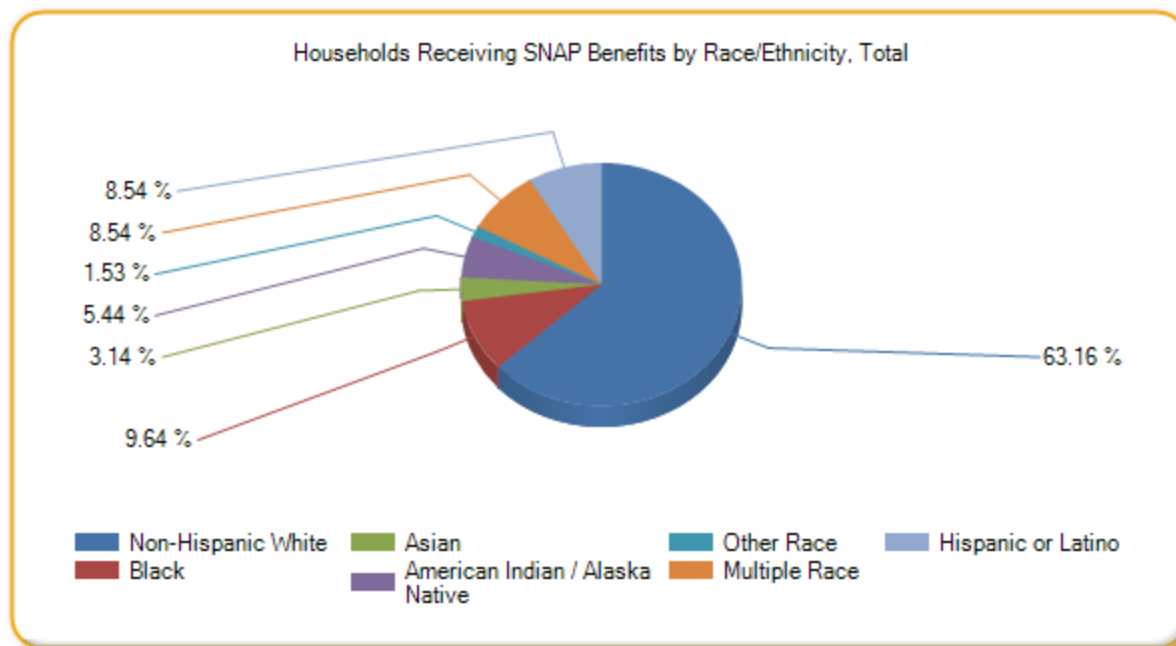

Households Receiving SNAP Benefits by Race/Ethnicity, Total

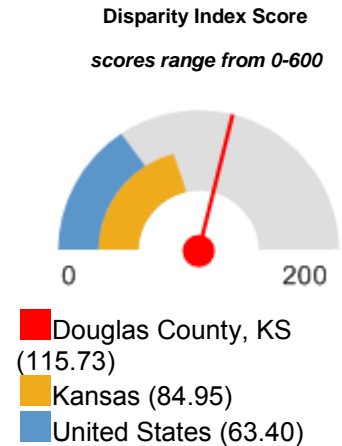

Population Receiving SNAP Benefits (ACS) Disparity Index

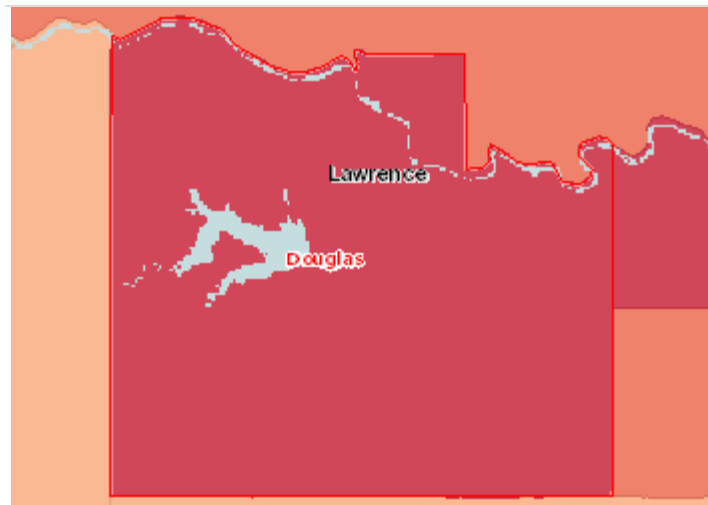
This indicator measures the difference in the percentage of households of different racial and ethnic groups receiving SNAP benefits using the Index of Disparity (ID). The ID assesses the magnitude of variation in indicator percentages across demographic groups relative to the indicator percentage for the total population.

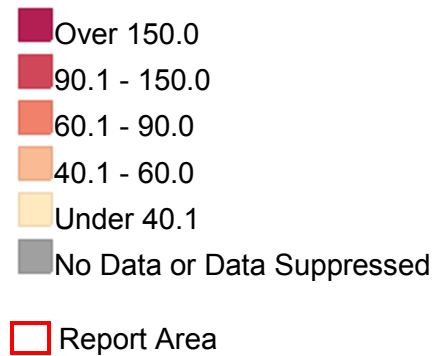

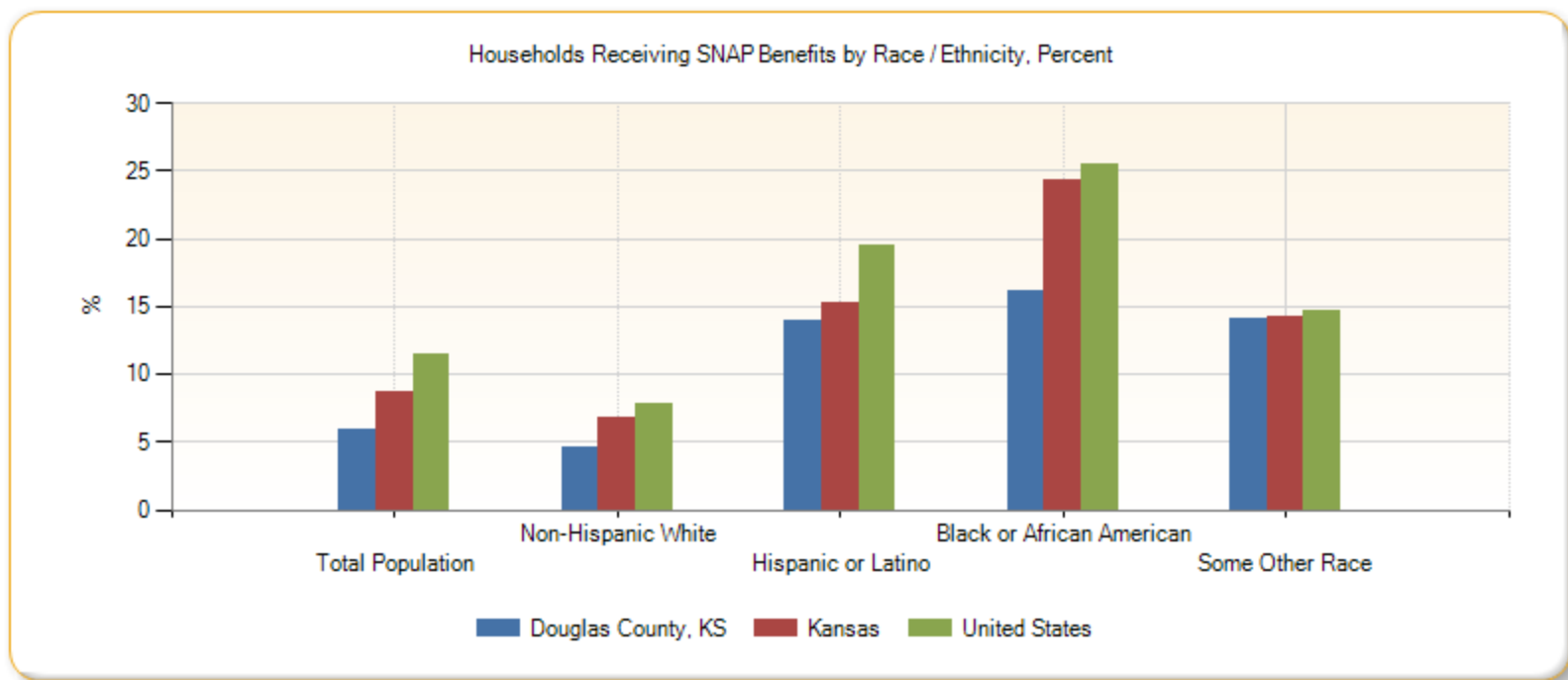


Households Receiving SNAP Benefits, Disparity Index Score by PUMA, ACS 2008-12



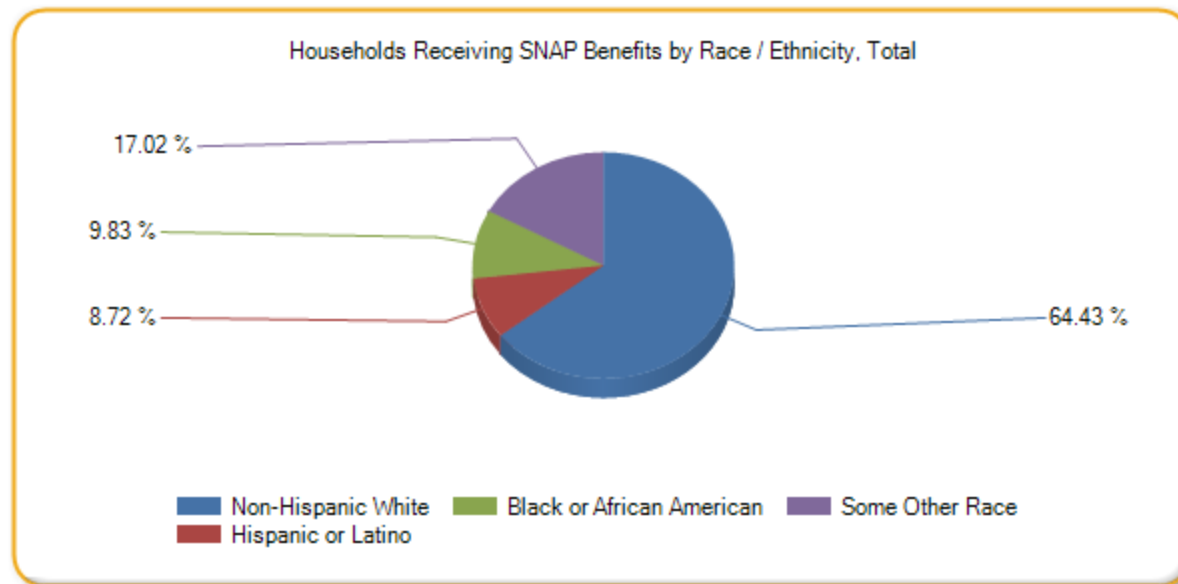

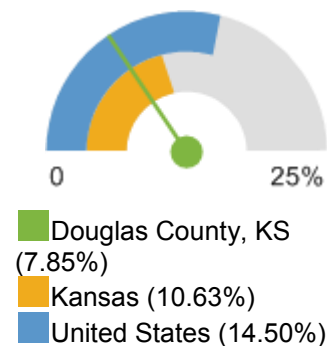


Population Receiving SNAP Benefits (SAIPE)

This indicator is relevant because it assesses vulnerable populations which are more likely to have multiple health access, health status, and social support needs; when combined with poverty data, providers can use this measure to identify gaps in eligibility and enrollment.

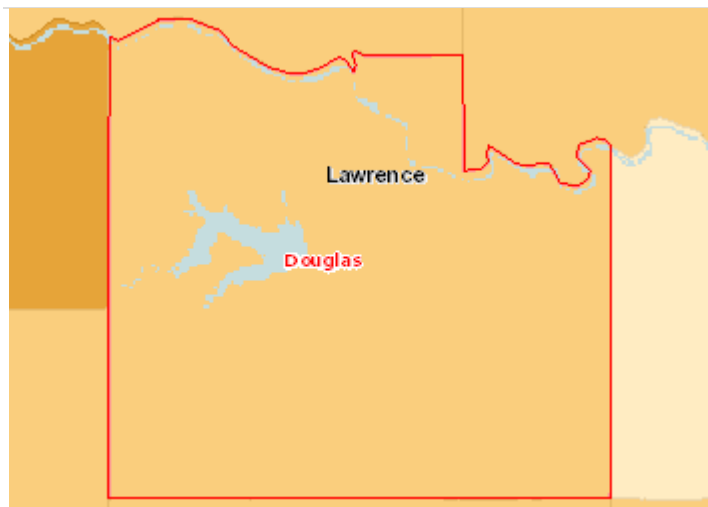
