

FY17 Iowa Partnerships for Success Iowa Youth Survey Services

Instructions: IPFS funded counties are required to provide services to promote the [Iowa Youth Survey \(IYS\)](#) during each year of the project. Below are service expectations for FY17. These services should all be provided on a reoccurring basis throughout FY17 and reported in the IPFS Quarterly Progress Report through Iowagrants.gov. Services

- Contact the school districts in your county and find out who is responsible for reviewing the IYS reports and disseminating the IYS data.
- Once FY17 data are available, contact each school district's IYS point of contact to discuss results and brainstorm ways that the data can be used or shared. Some items for discussion include:
 - Does the school have a review process? Who is involved?
 - How does the school envision using these data?
 - How does the school disseminate IYS information with staff, parents/guardians and community members?
- Present county IYS data to the coalition/Collaboration Council and discuss results/changes.
- Contact the Board of Health/Board of Supervisors to see if these groups have accessed/reviewed the most recent IYS county data.
 - If they have not, provide a presentation about the results. Coalition members could assist in providing this service.
- Provide media outreach on county IYS data
 - Write an article about the results of the county IYS data.
 - Utilize the IYS press release template from IDPH (to be provided on the IDPH workstation in spring 2017) or create one on your own.

FYI: Reports from the fall 2016 survey will be released beginning in March 2017 with the state report and county reports in May. These reports along with other substate reports will be posted on the [Iowa Youth Survey](#) website. School districts and private schools will receive their reports in April 2016, with reports e-mailed to Superintendents and the IYS Coordinators.
