

## **FY19 Iowa Partnerships for Success Iowa Youth Survey Services**

**Instructions:** IPFS funded counties are required to provide services to promote the [Iowa Youth Survey \(IYS\)](#) during each year of the project. Below are service expectations for FY19. These services should all be provided on a recurring basis throughout FY19 and reported in the IPFS Quarterly Progress Report through [Iowagrants.gov](http://Iowagrants.gov). State and county reports, along with other substate reports will be posted on the [Iowa Youth Survey](#) website beginning in March 2019. School reports are not posted to the IYS website; those schools receive their reports directly.

### **Services**

- Contact the school districts that participated in the 2018 IYS in your county and find out who is responsible for reviewing the IYS report and disseminating the data prior to April 1, 2019. IDPH will provide a list of all schools that participated in the 2018 IYS by March 1, 2019.
- Between April 12 and May 12, 2019, contact each school district's IYS point of contact to discuss results and brainstorm ways that the data can be used or shared. Some items for discussion include:
  - Does the school have a review process? Who is involved?
  - How does the school envision using these data?
  - How does the school disseminate IYS information with staff, parents/guardians and community members?
  - How you can collaborate with the schools in using their data (grant applications, assessment processes, press releases, community forums, etc.)?
- After May 24, 2019, present 2018 IYS county results to the coalition/Collaboration Council and discuss results/changes.
- Prior to May 24, 2019, contact the Board of Health and Board of Supervisors to see if these groups plan to review the 2018 IYS county results.
  - If they have, inquire as to their plans and offer assistance and to be part of their process.
  - If they have not, schedule a time after May 24 to discuss and review the results with them. Coalition members could assist in providing this service.
- Provide media outreach on county IYS data
  - Write an article about the results of the county IYS data.
  - Utilize the IYS press release template from IDPH (found on the Workstation under Implementation>Press Release Examples & Templates or create one on your own. All press releases must be submitted to IDPH for review and approval prior to distribution.
